Mullen students to show films at An High

Seventh grade World History students at Mullen school -- Ty Kvanvig, Teven Marshall and Lexi Rice -- will exhibit short history films near Washington, D.C. on June 6.

Kvanvig, Marshall and Rice have been chosen to have their films exhibited at the American History Film Project showcase at Annandale (Va.) High School.
